Safety and Maintenance Guidelines

1

proper operation

After use, rinse the brush head with clean water, air-dry it, and store it to prolong its service life.

2

forbidding act

Do not apply excessive force to avoid breaking the brush head and causing it to become lodged in the pipeline, which may lead to secondary blockage.

3

scope of application

Only for small drains such as bathrooms and kitchen sinks. Not for toilets or large drains.

FAQ

How long can a brush remove hair?

As shown in the figure, a single brush can remove hair clumps up to several tens of centimeters in length at once, with the exact length depending on the degree of hair entanglement and the blockage of the duct.

What should be done if the water still flows slowly after cleaning?

If the water flow remains obstructed after cleaning, it may indicate stubborn dirt or grease in the deeper sections of the pipes. We recommend a second cleaning using hot water or a specialized pipe unclogging agent.

Correct usage steps

Three easy steps to clear

01

Insert: Fully insert the brush head into the drain until the handle is flush with the sink edge.

02

Pull-and-rotate: While repeatedly pulling up and down, rotate the handle clockwise or counterclockwise to ensure the bristles fully 'hook' the hair.

03

Remove and clean: Slowly pull the brush out, remove the tangled hair from the bristles and discard it. Repeat the process until the tube is clear.

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
